# STEER AUCTION TERMS OF SALE

*Despite sometimes calling our donors “buyers” and our pledges “sales”, a winning bid is not a sales transaction but a pledge to contribute to the Show.*

## **BIDDING**

All lots sell to the highest bidder. The auctioneer will settle any disputes and his decision is final.

## **BIDDER NUMBERS**

All donors must be registered and have an assigned bidder number. Please confirm how you want your name to be recognized by the auctioneer at bidder registration.

## **PURCHASE COMMITMENT AGREEMENTS**

A purchase commitment is a contract and will be honored as such by the Show. Your purchase commitment will automatically be applied to lot purchases at the respective auction. **To prevent confusion and double purchases, your purchases at auction should be made in the same name as your purchase commitment.** You will be billed for the total amount of your purchase commitments or your auction purchases, whichever is greater. If you do not purchase at auction, your full purchase commitment becomes a donation to the Show.

## **PURCHASE CONFIRMATION**

A volunteer will assist you with your purchase confirmation on iPads where you will indicate your contribution to the lot purchase and your promise of payment. The Purchase Confirmation must have your correct name and donation amount. Your purchase is a non-refundable donation to the Show.

## **PAYMENT**

You must make full payment to the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo™ for your auction lot purchases by May 15, 2025. **Resell credits are not available on Junior Market Auction lots.** Payments for auction purchases and purchase commitments from foundations or charities will be reviewed individually and all benefit acceptances will be determined by individual foundation policies. Please review your foundation policy before accepting any donor benefits.

## **DONOR RECOGNITION**

Recognition will only be given to individuals who contribute to the lot purchase. A maximum of four individuals will receive recognition (print, video, audio, badges, donor benefits, banners, etc.) per lot. A couple (individual and spouse) is recognized as one individual. Please indicate these individuals on the purchase confirmation.

## **GUARANTEED PREMIUMS**

The Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo™ has established a schedule of Guaranteed Premiums to be paid to all eligible junior market show exhibitors who have won ribbons while competing in their individual class. In return for the Guaranteed Premium, all animals become the property of the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo at the time the ribbon is awarded. The Guaranteed Premium amount is all an exhibitor should expect to receive. Donors should note that there is no correlation between the amount bid for a specific animal and the Guaranteed Premium paid to the animal's exhibitor.

Once guaranteed premiums are paid to the exhibitors, the net proceeds from the auction are contributed to the Educational Fund to support the Show's commitment to the youth of Texas and education.



# STEER AUCTION DONOR BENEFITS

## DONOR BENEFITS

The Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization. The amount of the donation that may be deductible for federal tax purposes is the excess value donated by the donor over the value of the goods and services received. Consult your tax professional for more information. Please see the Steer Auction Benefits Guide for details on auction benefit determinations. **NOTE: If payment is not received by the deadline, any eligible benefits may be forfeited. If benefits are missed due to late payment, the tax letter will indicate they were not received.**

## HIDES

The Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo will put forth their best effort to secure hides that replicate the animal hides sold for a closing bid of \$5,000 or above. **The exact hide of the animal will not be available.**

## BUCKLES

Steer Auction Buckles are distributed to recognized donors on auction day. Qualified Elite Lot buckles are ordered post Show.

## MEAT PACKAGE AND GIFT CARD BENEFITS

Only high quality, commercially sourced meat will be used to fulfill meat package benefits. Meat packages must be confirmed by eligible donors' post Show. Declining meat benefits does not reduce the amount owed to the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo. **Meat Package and Gift Card Benefits will not be ordered if your donation is not paid in full by May 15, 2025.** Meat packages not picked up during the allotted time period will be considered a donation to the Show and purchase commitments will not be refunded. The Show will notify donors of pick-up dates.

## BADGES

Donations to any of the six qualifying auctions; Wine Auction, Lamb & Goat Auction, Poultry Auction, School Art Auction, Swine Auction and Steer Auction are eligible for Auction Donor Badges. Donors are eligible to receive one gold badge for every \$10,000 donated, up to a max of 12 gold badges. Donations to include auction day purchases, purchase commitments and cash donations. Badges are received for the 2026 Show. **Registered Buying Groups with the Show are not eligible for badges but awarded to the individual donor contributing to the Buying Group.** 501(c)(3) Buying Organizations receive badges based on their total donation and are treated as an individual donor. Each 2025 individual Champion Lot Donor (Lots 1 – 34) is eligible to receive one personalized silver Champion Lot Donor badge for the 2026 Show.

## BENEFIT SELECTION AND ACCEPTANCE

If a donor does not respond to communication regarding benefits, the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo will assume all benefits declined.

# STEER AUCTION

## Donation Levels and Benefits Guide for an Auction Donor

### DONOR BENEFITS

#### CHAMPION LOT

- » A Champion Lot Donor is a recognized donor (maximum of 4 recognized partners per lot) who donates on a Champion Lot: lots 1 - 36.
- » Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Lot Donors (lots 1 & 2) receive up to 4 meat packages or gift cards per donor.
- » Champion Lot Donors (lots 3 – 36) are eligible for up to 4 meat packages or gift cards per lot.
  - » *Minimum of \$2,500 per donor contributed to the lot, max 1 package per donor, per lot.*

- » Premium Lot Donors are eligible for up to 4 meat packages or gift cards per lot.
  - » *Minimum of \$2,500 per donor contributed to the lot, max 1 package per donor, per lot.*
- » Premium Lot Donors receive 2 "Premium Lot Donor" belt buckles per lot on auction day.

#### ELITE LOT

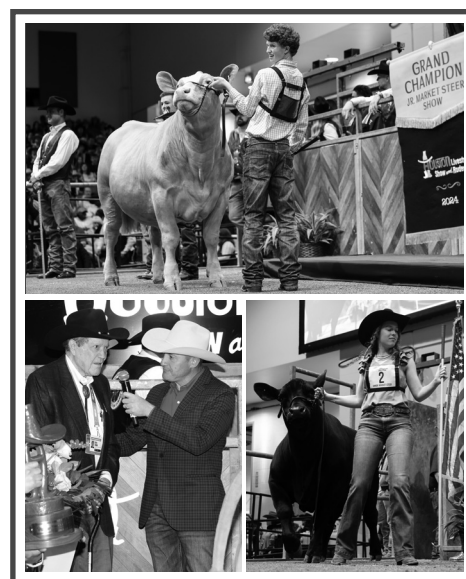
- » An Elite Lot Donor is a donor (maximum of 4 recognized partners per lot) who donates on a 3<sup>rd</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup> place lot that closes for a minimum of \$10,000. (Refer to auction catalog for exact lot numbers.)
- » Elite Lot Donors are eligible for up to 4 meat packages or gift cards per lot.
  - » *Minimum of \$2,500 per donor contributed to the lot, max 1 package per donor, per lot.*
- » Elite Lots are eligible for 2 "Elite Lot Donor" personalized belt buckles per lot.
  - » *Personalization will be collected after Show.*

## 501(c)3 BUYING ORGANIZATION QUALIFICATIONS AND BENEFITS

### Lamb & Goat, Poultry, School Art, Steer, Swine and Wine Auctions

The Silver Spur Club's mission is to recognize donors committed to supporting HLSR long term through the auctions where donations benefit HLSR exhibitors and HLSR's Education Fund. Donor recognition should be meaningful and impactful and in the best interest of the long-term success and sustainability of HLSR.

### YEARLY ORGANIZATION BENEFITS

Qualifying Silver Spur 501(c)3 buying organization members must donate a cumulative total of \$50,000 or more at any or all the above listed Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo™ auctions. Monies may be donated in the form of auction day purchases, cash donations or unmatched purchase commitments. Buying organizations must make all payments under the name of the respective entity.

### CLUB BENEFITS

After the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of consecutive membership, you are in the Silver Spur Club and your total amount donated is tracked for cumulative benefits that are awarded based upon cumulative donation amount. Accumulation will occur regardless of whether or not an annual total of \$50,000 is met.

### YEARLY 501(C)3 BUYING ORGANIZATION MEMBER BENEFITS

501(c)3 buying organizations must contribute \$50,000 in one Show year at qualifying HLSR auctions to receive the yearly benefits which include (yearly benefits are for the following Show year):

#### \$50,000 - \$99,999:

- » **Donor Recognition:** Silver Spur Buying Organizations will receive recognition on a donor board by the Louis M. Pearce Board Room and on the donor banner at the 2026 Auctions.
- » **Directors' Club Guest Passes:** Each qualifying Silver Spur Buying Organization will receive one pass per \$5,000 spent. The maximum number of passes a member can receive is 40 (and 4 per day).
- » **Silver Spur Gala:** Invitation for 2 to the 2026 Silver Spur Gala.
- » **Parking Pass:** Purple Lot parking pass (sponsor parking across Kirby from NRG Stadium).

#### \$100,000 and above:

- » **Donor Recognition:** Silver Spur Buying Organizations will receive recognition on a donor board by the Louis M. Pearce Board Room and on the donor banner at the 2026 Auctions.
- » **Directors' Club Guest Passes:** Each qualifying Silver Spur Buying Organization will receive one pass per \$5,000 spent. The maximum number of passes a member can receive is 40 (and 4 per day).
- » **Silver Spur Gala:** Invitation for 2 to the 2026 Silver Spur Gala.
- » **Parking Pass:** Directors Lot parking pass
- » **Board Room Access:** Buying organization donating at least \$100,000 receive access and charging privileges to the Louis M. Pearce Jr. Board Dining Room for themselves and one guest. Only one access card will be issued per Silver Spur buying organization.

### CUSTOMIZED 501(C)3 BUYING ORGANIZATION MEMBER GIFTS

501(c)3 Buying Organization Silver Spur Members will receive custom gifts based on years of membership or cumulative contributions. Members will have the option to receive a gift card of equal value in lieu of the trophy saddle and rack.

- » 2<sup>nd</sup> year consecutive members receive one Silver Spur watch, bracelet, purse, or briefcase
- » 3<sup>rd</sup> year consecutive members receive one set of silver spurs and silver spur bag.
- » After the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of consecutive membership, gifts are awarded based upon cumulative purchases. Accumulation will occur regardless of whether or not an annual total of \$50,000 is met. However, in order to receive additional benefits, including donor board recognition, the \$50,000 total must be met. The customized gifts are listed below:
  - » \$250,000: 4 – sterling silver "\$250K" badges
